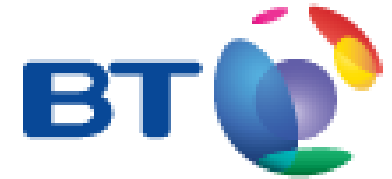

# Some facts

- ✓ STRATEGIC will focus on **cloud computing for e-government services**, with the goal of enabling public sector organizations to fully leverage the benefits of public cloud services
- ✓ STRATEGIC emerges from **leading edge R&D results** (Optimis Toolkit, VENUS-C, STORK and Semiramis projects) in order to open new horizons in the secure and privacy friendly migration, adaptation, governance and development of public cloud services.
- ✓ The STRATEGIC framework and services will be piloted in **Genoa, Stari Grad** and **Camden**. These services include:
  - a unique virtual counter for enterprise services (Genoa)
  - a service that will interact with the UK public service network (CAMDEN)
  - a service for certificate issues and the internal IT services (Stari Grad)
- ✓ STRATEGIC is a 3-year pilot B CIP project (call id CIP-ICT-PSP-2013-7; Objective 1.1 Cloud of Public Services) with a total funding of 2.381.000€





# Rationale & Objectives

- ✓ We will **cloud-enable several on-line public services published in a marketplace**, along with other existing governmental public cloud services in Genoa, Camden and Stari Grad
- ✓ We will create **adapted localized version of existing governmental services** for public bodies residing in other EU countries and regions
- ✓ We will compose **new innovative services** based on the composition, reuse and extension of existing public cloud services
- ✓ We will operate those services on the basis of the involvement of **real-users in real conditions** in order to validate the STRATEGIC developments
- ✓ We will evaluate the public services as a means of fine-tuning the STRATEGIC framework, while also eliciting a wide range of **best practices and policy development guidelines** for sustaining, extending and enhancing the scope of the STRATEGIC concept for public cloud services migration, development, adaptation and governance.



# Expected impact

- ✓ STRATEGIC will contribute to the provision of more **effective services** for citizens and enterprises
- ✓ STRATEGIC will give public administrations the opportunity to **benefit from the experience** of other public entities and to provide **cost-efficient** and **improved quality** electronic services
- ✓ STRATEGIC will offer the technology community a **secure framework** for the migration of online public services to cloud.
